### THINGS YOU NEED TO PREPARE BEFORE PARTICIPATING IN JOB TRAINING IN JAPAN

My name is Nguyen Van Vinh. I have just returned from Japan after finishing 7-month internship programme of Centre of International Training and Development, TNU University of Agriculture and Forestry in 2016. That was really a key experience in my entire life as I had learned a lot about my major, agriculture, equipped myself with plenty of useful stuff for my future job as well as had unforgettable memories in Japan.

#### **Learning Japanese before you go**

Japanese is a hieroglyphic language, so I had some difficulties when starting to learn it. Although teachers helped me a lot and I tried so hard to learn, but I realized that such an effort was not enough for me to overcome the language barrier when I arrived in Japan. I listened to my landlord carefully and observed how he worked, then took notes every single word and tried to memorize them with actions. When he taught me to do a thing, I did it right away. In the meantime, I had him check if it was right, then went on to do the rest of the work. That was the best way to learn new vocabulary. One month in Japan, I got used to communicating with people and my listening skills were improved a lot. Apart from work, I were able to share and chat more about daily stuff with my landlord.

### **Physical and attitude training**

The time I spent in the dormitory of the centre doing exercise was memorable for me as well as other students. Here I made friends with a lot of people, studied and trained under strict management of teachers. According to the timetable, we had to get up early at 6a.m to do a one-hour exercise, then studied Japanese and did exercise again in the afternoon. At first, I didn't get used to with strict and organized timetable, I felt pretty tired, but I was not until I arrived in Japan that I realized how important that I was well-prepared in Vietnam. However, the work became harder in harvest time when we had to get up at 2 or 3 a.m to harvest vegetables. Whenever I got tired, seeing the landlord, who was a 65-year-old, working as a young person made me think that I had to tried harder. I set my own timetable to study and work, so I succeeded in training myself to be conscious and persistent. That was also the reason why I stayed healthy during 5 months in Japan.

### **Preparing personal belongings and clothes**

Beside personal belongings such as toothbrush, toothpaste, shaver, books, and overalls, you need to bring with you thick coats as it is very cold in April and October (1 degree Celsius at night and about 10 degree Celsius in the morning). Raincoats are also necessary because it helps keep your body warm, dry and clean when harvesting vegetables at night.

### **Getting to know about Japanese culture**

Learning about culture, daily habits, customs, etc. of native people makes it much easier to get accustomed to a culture.

After 5 months, I have learned some basic things in daily life in Japan. The first thing is saying "thank you" whenever the landlord gives you something or whenever you make a mistake. This is an expression of respect in Japanese culture. If you want someone to respect you, respect them first, be honest and humble, be punctual. I regard the landlord as my relative, and he always treats me good.

The seminar was taken place with the appearance of Meritorious Teacher, Assistant Professor/Dr Nguyen Dinh Man - Rector; comrades from the Administrators; leaders from divisions, faculties as well as teachers and scientific research leaders who are students from Agricultural Science and Technology faculty.

The organization of the seminar is a compulsory thing to do in present, which will bring faith and encouragement for students and lecturers from the faculty to overcome difficulties, challenges and reach for new peaks.

The seminar was in charge of raising the awareness in science, also sharing new information within many fields: farming land management; environment management; veterinary feeding and cultivation.

The seminar was also a chance for teachers and lecturers working in the faculty to have a close view on doing research, keep their research on way to be completed and apply to train and educate not only their students but also the next young generations.

In a speech, Mr. Nguyen Dinh Man appreciated the efforts and dedication of all lecturers and officers of the Agriculture and Forestry Technology Faculty. The teaching methods, training quality applied on students depend most on those lecturers’ enthusiasm.

There were four science reports specialized in several topics:

- Mrs Tran Thi Thu Hien - MA, announce her thematic: “Information Technology usage in building land map, classification map which is used to serve the development of agricultural land in Dong Hy district, Thai Nguyen province
- Mrs. Dao Thi Thu Huong, MA, and her report: “Shallow rice and sustainable agricultural development to defend climate change in Vietnam”.
- Dr. Do Thi Van Giang and her scientist work: “Breeding development in Vietnam”.
- Mrs. Quyen Thi Dung, MA, with: “Shallow - exposed - dry irrigation and steady agriculture development”

The seminar was successfully organized in general and brought many effectiveness in studying and teaching research for lecturers and students. Many opinions were quite practical and suitable to the reality of the University.

**AGRICULTURE EXTENSION TRAINING SEMINAR FOR AGRICULTURAL UNIVERSITIES**

On November 25<sup>th</sup> morning, at University of Agriculture and Forestry (UAF), NAEC (National Agriculture Extension Center) – in the collaboration with the University, organized the Agriculture extension training seminar in Agriculture universities.

In the speech during the seminar, Dr Tran Van Khoi - Director of NAEC informed: agricultural cadres number are being increased currently, as well as their qualifications; however, the grassroots' (commune, hamlet, village) are quite low and unequal due to the lack of general regulations for recruitment standard and treatment regime. In details, there are nationally about 24% of commune agricultural cadres who haven't got the intermediate level, and over 55% of agricultural collaborators haven't been technically trained.

According to the present statistics, there are nationally over 8,700 agricultural enterprises which occupy more than 3.5% of the total number of economic firms around the country, meanwhile the number of labors is about 380,000, which are predictably increased 10% each

year within the period of 2017 – 2020, about over 65,000 ones.

At the conference, lots of delegates suppose that grassroots agriculture extension commissioners not only are the bridge to deliver technical and scientific progress but also directly work with farmers to discover new agriculture extension models. In fact, these commissioners play a very important part in developing the local agriculture, which is particularly giving instructions to farmers as well as conducting the schedule with the authorities for producing, detecting and restraining diseases in time, and connecting to organizations in vocational training for farmers. Thus, beyond the arrangement renovation and power resource for agriculture extension, provinces and cities also need to invest expenditure for local agriculture extension activities and to boost the qualification for the multi level system of agriculture extension, especially grassroots level. To Agriculture universities, extremely to the agriculture extension department, the priority is training soft skills for students, some of those can be listed such as: teamwork, observation, listening, transmitting and receiving responded information, analyzing, visualization.

**THE FOURTH SCIENTIFIC AND TECHNOLOGICAL EXHIBITION**

In the afternoon of 10<sup>th</sup> December, Thai Nguyen University in collaboration with Hoa Lac Hi-Tech Service Centre held the fourth scientific and technological exhibition with a slogan "sharing knowledge - creating future". This was the event to display technology and investment contracts for students, young scientists and startups.

Continuing the success of previous ones (held in Hanoi, Danang and Ho Chi Minh city), this time, the exhibition attracted over 300 students from all universities that were under Thai Nguyen university management. Its aim was to encourage students to do researches and startup activities, heading to merchandising innovations and globalizing startup companies.



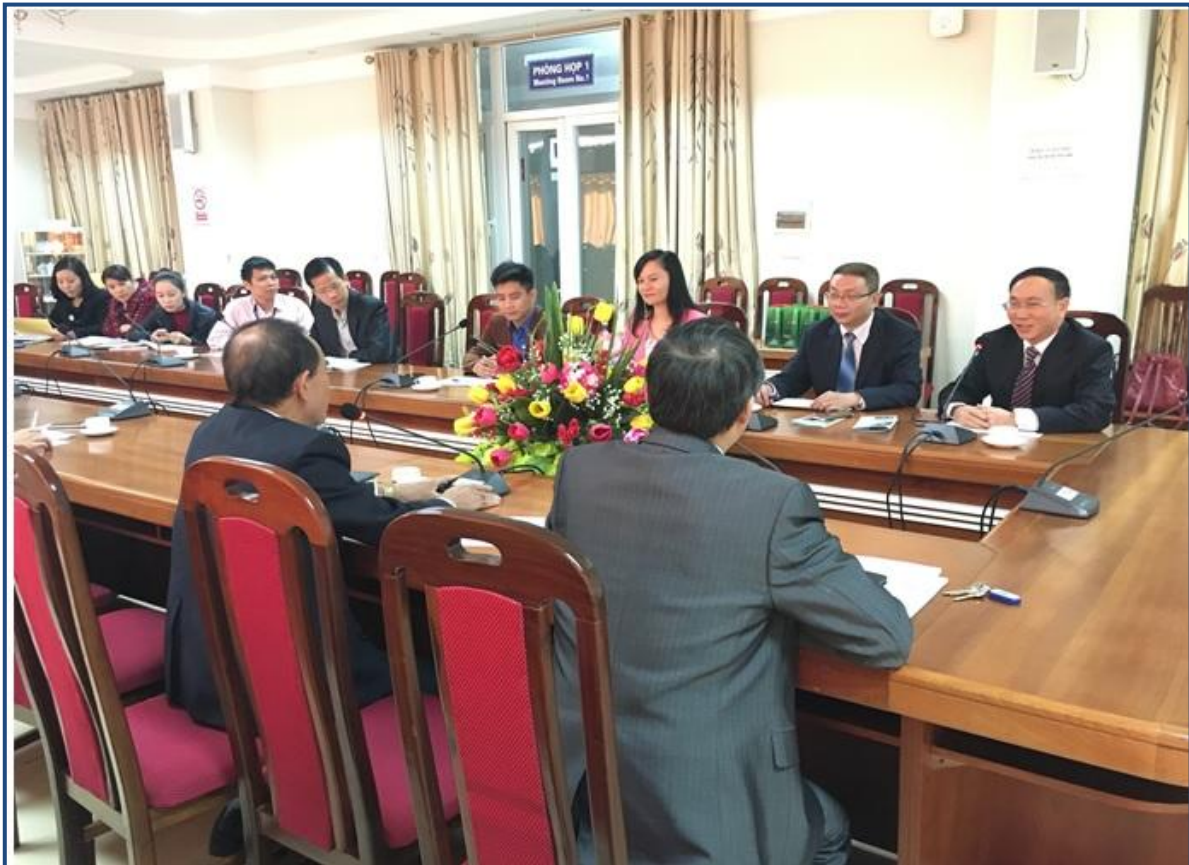

### TNU UNIVERSITY OF SCIENCES' YOUTH UNION CONTRIBUTES TO SUPPORT PEOPLE IN CENTRAL REGION

On October 18<sup>th</sup> 2016, TNU University of Sciences' Youth Union officially launched the donation program to help Central Region flood victims. During launched time from October 18<sup>th</sup> 2016 to the end of October 31<sup>th</sup> 2016, the program's fund has been raised about 21,375,000 VND.

In recent days, heavy rains have caused floods which made many people in Central Region provinces die, lost and injure. Fast moving waters washed away hundreds of houses. Floods surround houses in Central Region after torrential rain submerged tens of thousands of houses. Floods also left thousands homeless whose life was at stake because of the lack of foods.



To bring into play the nation's traditions, and express feelings and responsibility of TNU University of Sciences' Youth, Youth Union Committee launched a donation, appeal the sincere heart of all students in the whole school for people in Central Region provinces.

Although the gift for people in Central Region is not large, it contains in the spirit and solidarity of TNU University of Sciences' Youth Union for people in flooded areas. We hope that people here can overcome difficulties and settled daily life as well as production soon.



### GIVING GIFTS AND FREE MEDICAL TREATMENTS TO REMOTE ETHNIC GROUPS

On 18th December, at Phu Thuong primary school, Phu Thuong commune (Vo Nhai district), the Communist Youth Union and Student's Association of TNU University of Medicine and Pharmacy started a campaign "Winter volunteer work - giving love and sharing warmth" to giving gifts and free medical treatments to students of the school. The total expense of the campaign was 40 million VND.
